'E' is for Easter

Instructions

Trace

Daffodil and small letters Orange Micron Pen

Leaves - Micron Pen Green

Rest of design - White Pencil

Embossing

Lines of letter 'E', line around small letters, small ball
Outer border lines, small ball.

Circle around letter 'E' and small letter - Large sun tool
Painting - Felt tip pens and fine brush - FRONT
Daffodil - Lemon Yellow 1st layer, Tangerine shadows
stamens micron pen orange
Small letters - Lemon Yellow 1st layer, Tangerine 2nd
layer.

Leaves - Lemon Yellow 1st layer, Emerald 2nd layer
Adding colour around outer border - BACK

Blendable pencil orange - blend with Zest it oil.

Grid Work - Fine Straight - BACK

Place on grid diagonally

Emboss (Micro Ball) diagonal lines within the letter 'E'
Remove from grid

Perforate inside crossed section using a 4 needle tool
cut these 4 holes into 'X's

Corner designs - Multi Grid 2(Optional)

Finishing

Score and fold where shown, cut off corners where shown
Place a piece of coloured card behind the design before
securing with cello tape.

Place your design onto a folded card.
